Lizeta has been severely paralyzed by polio since age 14. Unlike other girls of her age, Lizeta felt she lost everything including all the good things that come with being a girl. Our founder had a different vision for her: not to let polio stop Lizeta from reaching her God given potential. Now, Lizeta will be able to go to places she's never been and do things she could never do. In fact, she plans on biking to the farm to grow her own peanuts from which she hopes to generate an income. Thanks to FNTE donors!
