Stories like Rachel (pictured below) shows the long lasting difference FNTE is making in the lives of the less fortunate. We don't just give them food or money; we teach them and equip them and the results are for generations.

## Outcome of Your Partnership with FNTE

- 63 families each received our care package (2 vaccinated bulls, a plow, and training)
- 140 children are schooled as a result
- 3 clean water wells with 9 people trained to maintain them
- 11,000 people with clean water every day as a result
- 49 acres of school property that we are raising funds to build on
- 2,000 trees planted on the school property for school construction purpose
- A ranch of 12 young cattle to grow more bulls to give
- 4,000 people received eye glasses from our eye care clinic
- 40 people received dental care at our dental clinic

- 51 women each granted our micro-financing envelope for their start-up hand craft business
- 22 people went to Burkina Faso with us to serve and witnessed the difference being made
- The local empowerment across the villages is immeasurable
